ack in 2011, I was finishing up a year of service as one of the Associate Pastors at a Southern Baptist Church in Hawthorne, California. We had performed the Crucifixion Experience there several times and we even took TCE on the road to a few other churches. Meanwhile the Lord doubled the size of the church. Before I left, a friend of mine named Pastor Amy Ayano, gave me a name and phone number on a small piece of paper and she said, "Call this lady." I didn't know who the lady was or why Pastor Amy said that I should call her, but I put the paper in my pocket and forgot about it. A few days later I found the paper and I stuck it in a drawer. A few months later, I was working on editing one of our video presentations of "The Crucifixion Experience" in Nigeria, I came across the small piece of paper, so I called the number on it.

The lady's name was Sadie, she was the director of a food pantry called "SAVES" in Culver City, California. I had never had a desire to start a food distribution ministry, but I really felt the Lord wanted me to go down there.

A few days later, I saw how many people they helped, and what an amazing difference they made for families in their community. When all the families were helped and they were about to close for the day, I saw them throwing about 20-30 very large bags of extra bread, pastries, and other food in the trash dumpster. My heart was grieved. What a waste of food. There had to be a way to get that left-over food to people that need it. Sadie said that because GOD'S PURPOSE MINISTRIES is a non-profit organization (501c3), I was welcome to take the food! if I was sure I could safely and properly distribute it.





I told her I would, although I wasn't exactly sure what I was going to do with all that food. I loaded up my car with as much food as I could fit, which was about 15 large bags. I drove home to our apartment complex, set up a table in the courtyard, then put up a "FREE FOOD" sign.

Families came out to see what was going on, and soon every week, the hard-working but needy families in our building were enjoying free bread, pastries, and a wide variety of produce that they needed for their families. Every little bit helps. In the following weeks people in the community and the surrounding neighborhood started coming into our building to get food as well. A very big need was being met. News of all the free food spread quickly, and the ministry began to grow. I got my mom, Emily, involved. We developed a set of rules for conduct and distribution. We would also gather and pray together before we unload the food as a team.

More and more families began to benefit every week from God's provision and all of my Mom's hard work.

We are so grateful for the opportunity to serve our community in Jesus' Name.

TODAY, we are so blessed to be partnering with two local Trader Joe's Stores, the 99 Cent Only Store, and VIDA LIFE Ministries to provide food for between 250 families and homeless friends on a weekly basis, all across the Hollywood, Los Angeles, and San Fernando Valley areas. We have also partnered with Trader Joe's in the Northern California. We have connected Sister Hai, who went with us on our last Nigeria trip, with a Trader Joe's in the Oakland area and they are now helping to feed many needy families on a weekly basis are. Thanks to the faithful suport and generosity of our friends at Trader Joe's, the 99 Cent Only Store, and VIDA LIFE MINISTRIES, we are able to make a difference in the lives of so many people, in Jesus Name. We are also so greatful for our team of volunteers who help pick-up, deliver, and distribute food to the needy. The Bread of Life Team is Emily(Director), Anna, Ernesto, Martha, Hai, Edith, Levi, Rashawn, Elizabeth, Pastor Gaston and myself (Pastor George). Thank you Jesus!

There's an old saying, "Teamwork makes the dream work." or as God Word puts it in Deuteronomy 32:30, "One can send a thousand and two can send ten thousand to flight."
